No message means class is ON. Portfolio preparation available for high school students.
-First time students complete a series of drawing projects designed to lead from black and white contour drawing to pencil shading to working with color in pastel and acrylic paints. Emphasis is placed on drawing common objects from life. Repeat students are encouraged to explore acrylic painting on canvas of subjects from life with backgrounds designed from their imaginations. Each student is guided at his/her own level but is expected to work somewhat independently. A "working atmosphere" is fostered though the "love" of art is a PRIORITY. Focus, organizational skills, eye-hand coordination and respect for art and artists are promoted. Several art exhibitions are held in the winter and spring for students to show finished, framed work and experience a proper "art opening". Certificates are awarded and a scholarship competition is sponsored.
